Norgrove Railway is a rare, restored WW1-era steam-powered train built in 1917 on an unusual narrow-gauge track of 60cm (just under 2 ft). It was originally intended to ship to France for duty as a Trench Train. However, the war ended before it happened. It now winds through beautiful vineyards and orchards just east of El Campo Rd in Arroyo Grande.

Location is 2449 Brady Lane, AG (off El Campo Rd. near Hwy. 101).
